123 responses = 46% of our active MA meetings (267 Total)

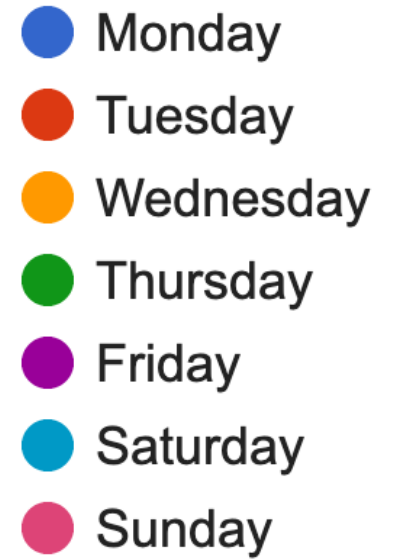
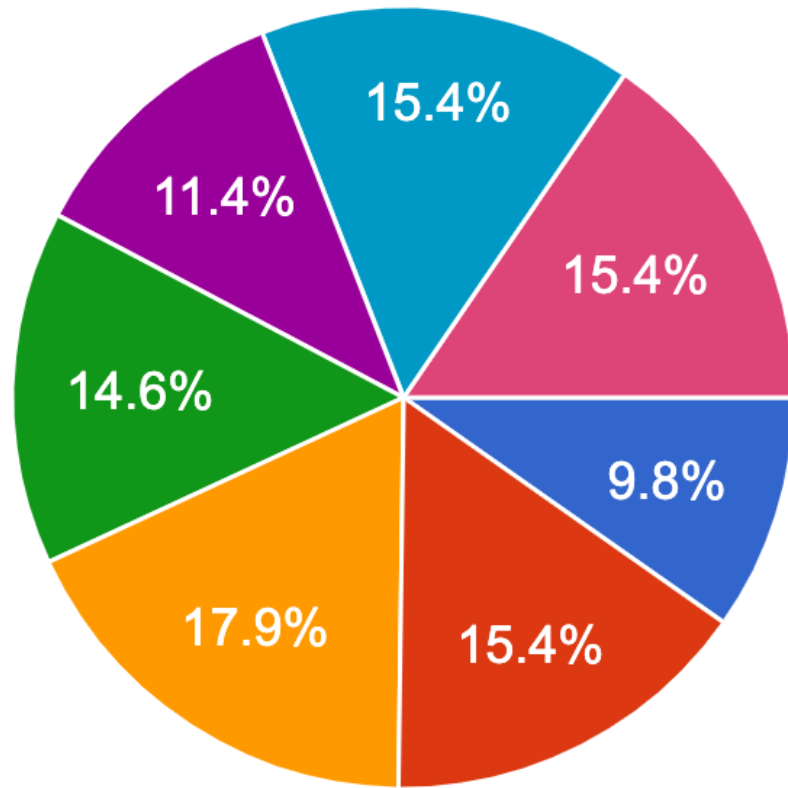
Responses from all over the state.

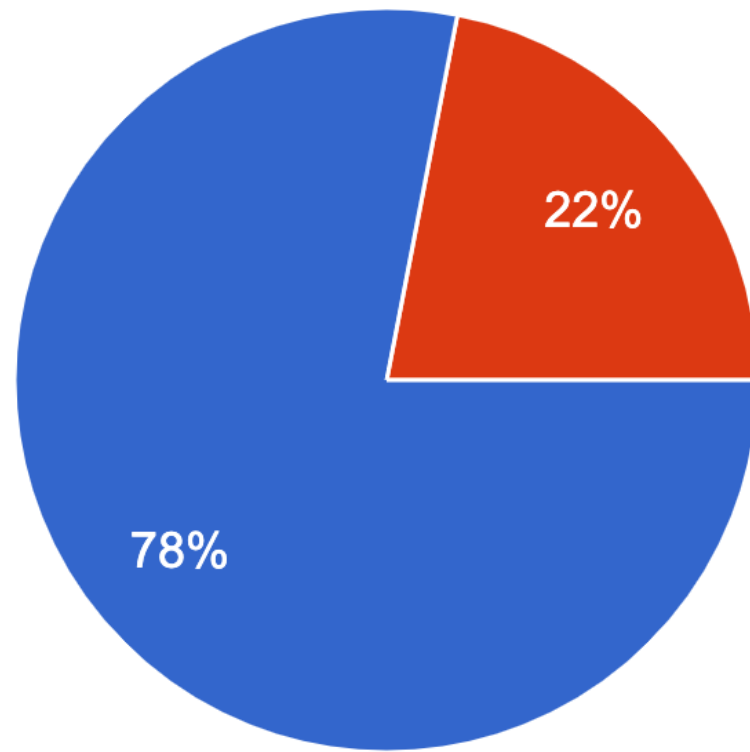
On what day does your group meet?

What is your role in the group?

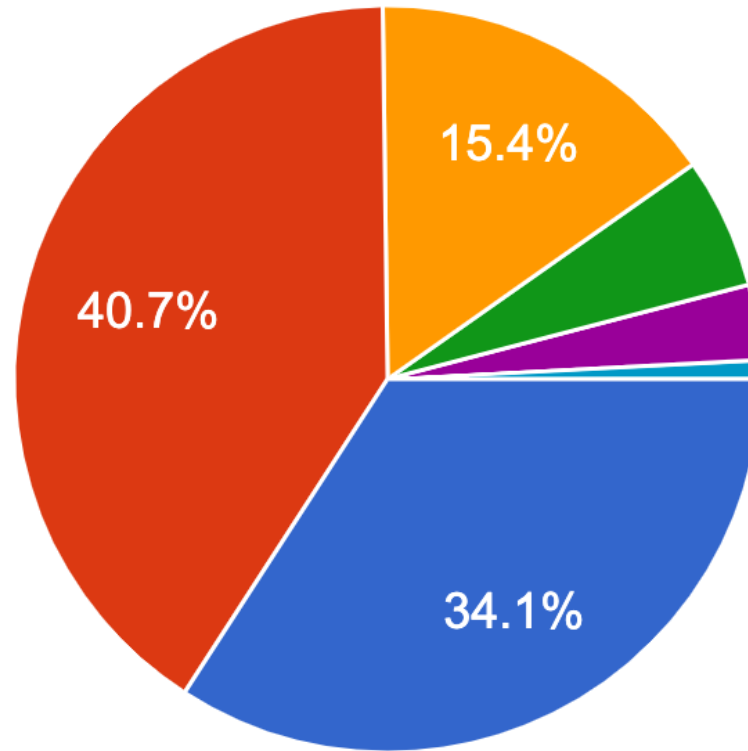

How is your group currently meeting?

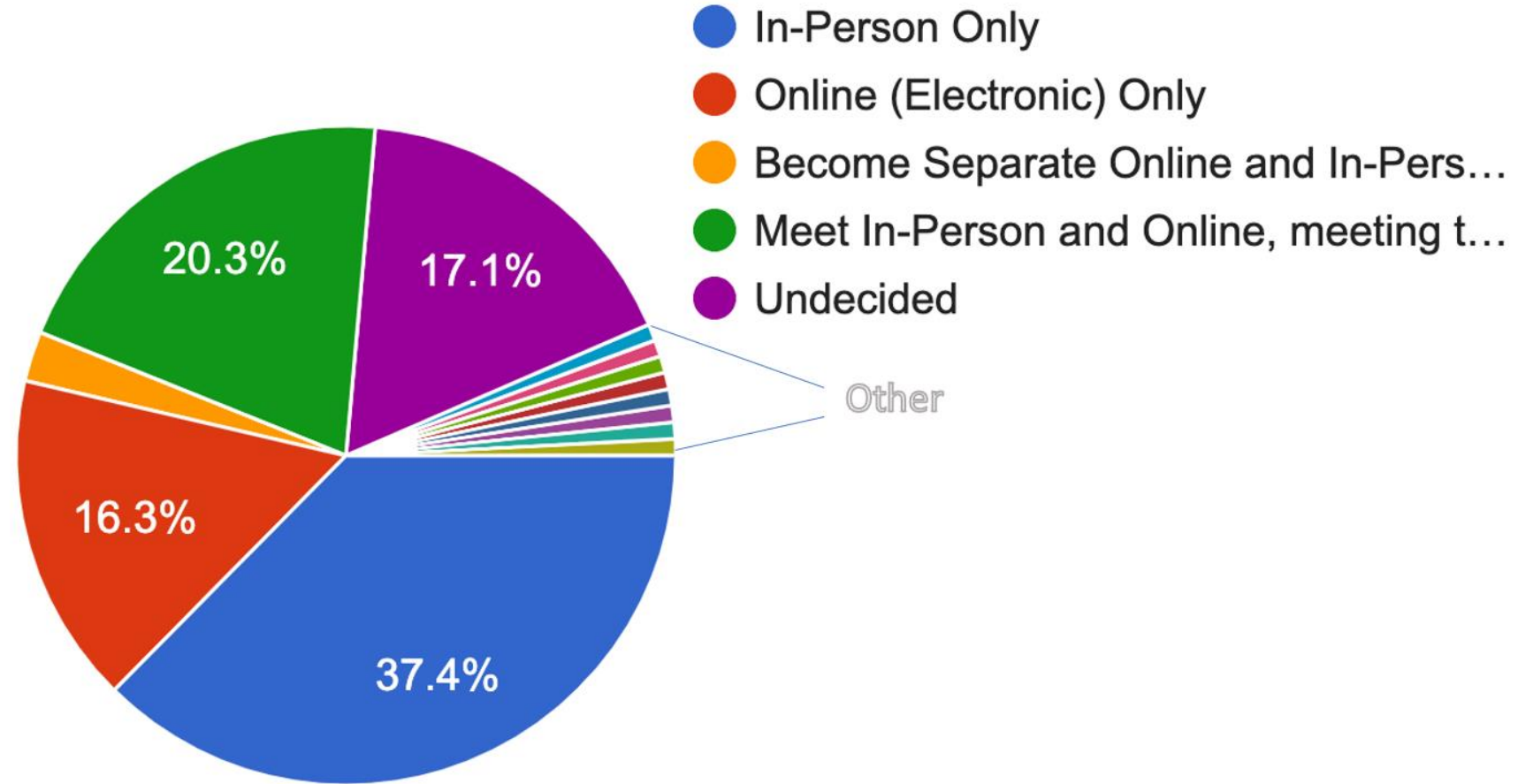

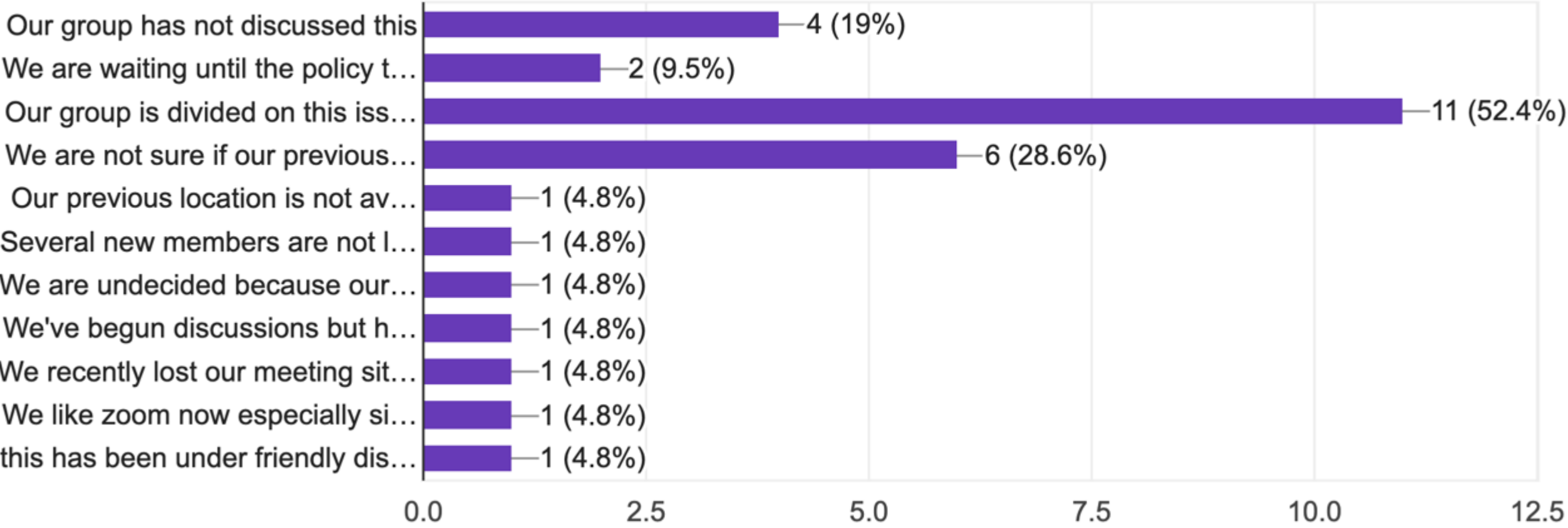
Reasons Why Groups are Undecided about how they will meet

21 responses

- Group cannot reach consensus
- Group has not discussed or waiting until after Spring Assembly
- Not sure can return to in-person meeting place or lost meeting site
- Concern about losing members that can't come in-person

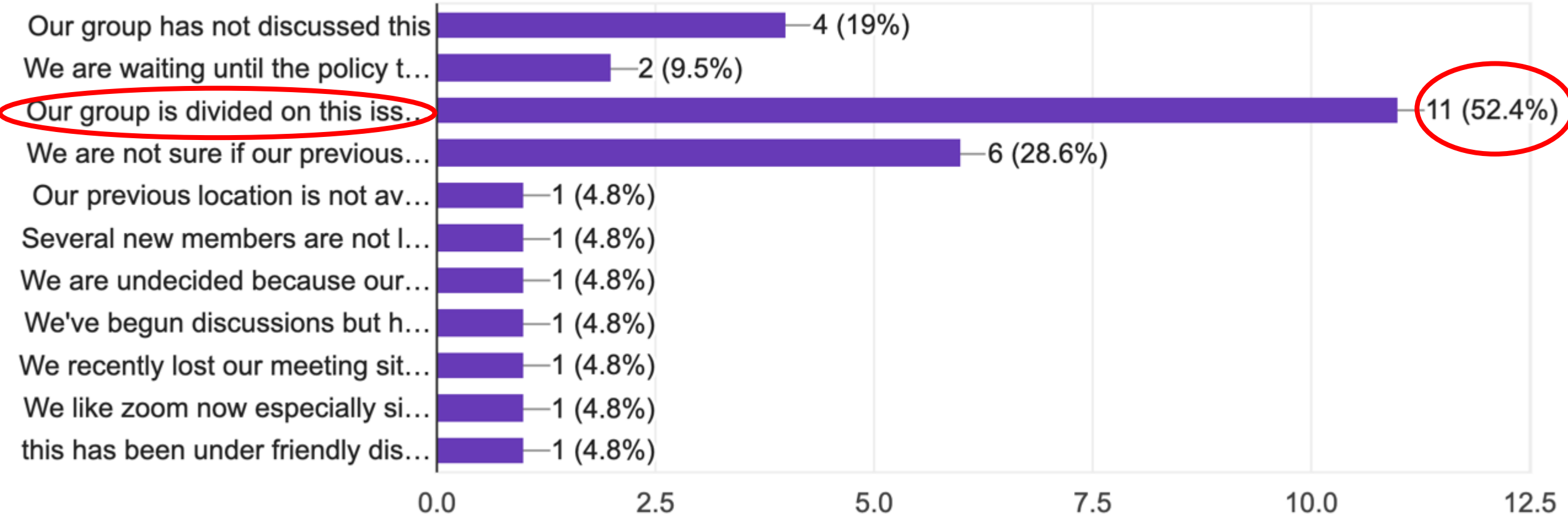
Why are you undecided

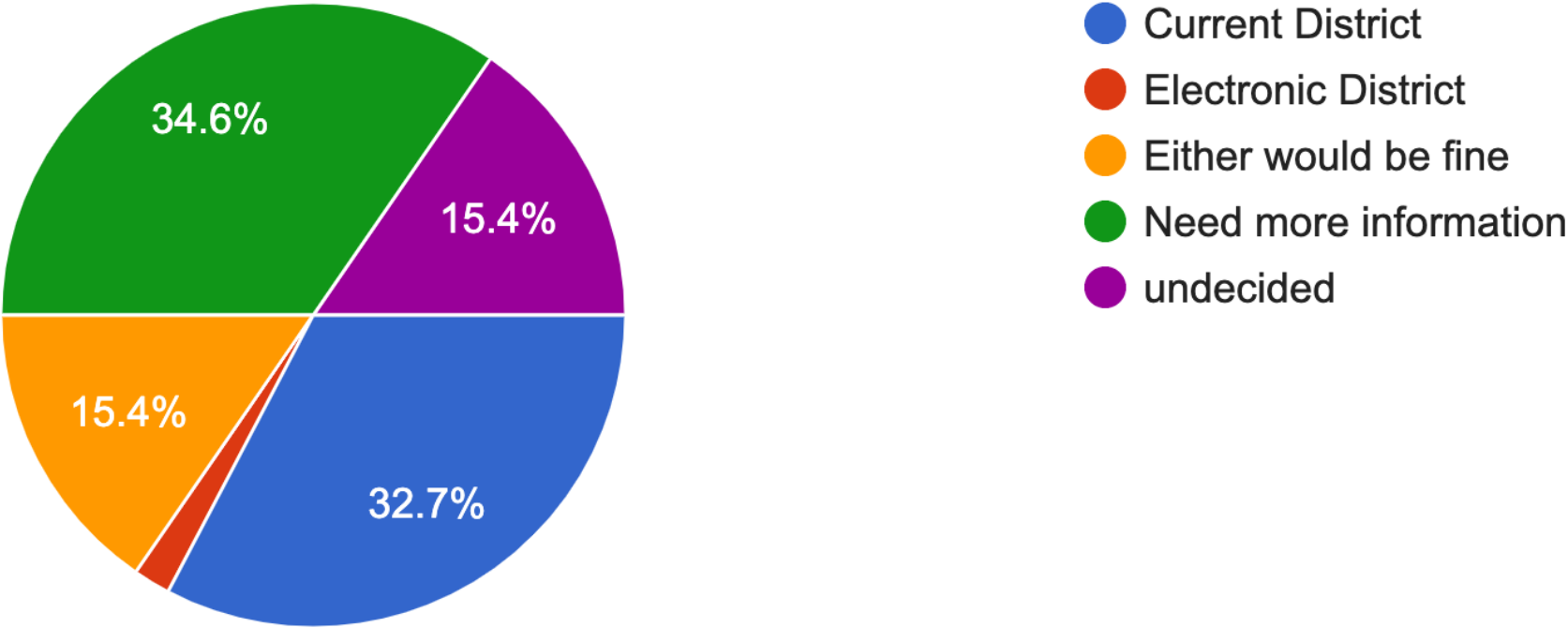
If you were an Online (Electronic) group in the future, would your group wish to remain part of our MA state service structure?

Key Take-Aways From This Survey

- The majority of surveyed area groups that will be electronic-only want to remain part of the area service structure.
- There are enough electronic-only groups that want to join an electronic-only district to fill at least one district.
- Geographic districts will need to decide how to accommodate electronic-only groups for district meetings if they apply and are accepted by the district.
- Group autonomy is part of the Al-Anon legacies (see Tradition 4)
